



Maintenance Instructions

Congratulations on selecting Rhino Shield Ceramic Coating system to protect your home!

To protect your investment, we recommend that you perform periodic cleaning maintenance. This will not only keep your home looking beautiful but also help your Rhino Shield system remain free of harmful airborne dirt and microorganism growth. We recommend cleaning your walls annually to remove surface dirt and stains.

Please follow these steps for cleaning:

- We recommend low-pressure power washing (500-600 psi with a maximum of 1,000 psi)
- A cleaning solution using TSP (found at Home Depot or Lowes) can be used in proper mixture.
- Be sure to thoroughly wash off any cleaning agent mix on the walls.
- Pressure nozzle should be 12" or more away from the walls.

Additional tips to enhance the durability of Rhino Shield:

- Check periodically for openings in the caulk joints around windows, doors, trim and siding.
- Prevent ponding of water around doorframes or siding in low areas.
- Keep gutters and roof surfaces in working order.
- Keep shrubs, trees and plants a minimum of one foot away from the property and trim.
- Sometimes dirt / gravel will build up over a period of time and can create an entrance for insects as well as water from underneath.
